Fit Testing – Bob explained that we could use the Greenfield Fire Dept.'s machine to fit test face pieces and we can pay one of their guys to come over and do these fit tests. Prudential Committee agreed.

Old Fire Alarm Boxes – 92 total. The Association is in the process of selling them.

The next Center County Fire meeting (from the COG) will be November 18 at the COG. At the last meeting it was noted that Prudential Committee and Selectboard Members should start attending.

Run statistics – review was done of run statistics – how many medical calls, how many fire calls, etc.

Long-term ambulance plans – Discussion followed about adding man-power for the Fire side of the Fire Department and starting a primary ambulance service that would create a revenue stream that would support part of it. Bob will bring some more concrete figures to the next meeting.
